



Biography of Mark A. Hutchison

Nevada Lieutenant Governor

In 2014, while serving as State Senator, Mark Hutchison won the general election to serve as Nevada's 34th Lieutenant Governor. Mark is a third-generation Nevadan. He and his wife Cary have six children and six grandchildren. Both Mark and his children were educated in Nevada's public school system.

After graduating from Bonanza High School, Mark earned a business administration degree, Phi Kappa Phi, from the University of Nevada, Las Vegas and received his law degree, magna cum laude, from Brigham Young University. He is a small business owner who built his law firm, Hutchison and Steffen, from the ground up starting in 1996, which is now one of Nevada's largest law firms, employing nearly 100 Nevadans.

As Lieutenant Governor, Mark is a member of Governor Brian Sandoval's cabinet and serves as President of the State Senate. He is also the Chairman of the Commission on Tourism, Chairman of the Governor's Committee on Energy Choice, Vice-Chairman of the State Board of Transportation, a member of the Board of the Governor's Office of Economic Development, a member of the Executive Budget Audit Committee, a member of the Governor's Commission on Homeland Security, Chairman of the Cyber Security Commission, and a member of the Board of Directors of the Public Education Foundation.

Mark is deeply honored by the trust Nevadans have placed in him to serve as Lieutenant Governor and since his election has been focused on being the hardest working and most effective Lieutenant Governor possible.
