The meeting of the Keep Nevada Working Task Force (KNWTF) will be conducted and may be attended in-person or via a remote technology system. Written public comment must be received prior to the start of the meeting and will be forwarded to the KNWTF for consideration. Please include "KNWTF Public Comment" in the subject area. Public comment will be included in the public record (meeting minutes) but will not necessarily be read aloud during the meeting. In compliance with Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) Chapter 241 (Open Meeting Law), the Committee is precluded from taking action on items raised via public comment which are not already on the agenda.

The Committee may take items out of order or combine items for consideration. Items may be pulled or removed from the agenda at any time. Public comment will be taken at the beginning and end of the meeting. The public may provide comment on any matter regardless of whether that matter is listed on the agenda. However, public comment that is willfully disruptive is prohibited, and individuals who willfully disrupt the meeting may be removed from the meeting. [NRS 241.030(5)(b)]. Once all items on the agenda are completed, the meeting will adjourn.
